



School Rules

- Self Discipline is the worth word of the school.
- Corporal punishment is banned in the school.
- A student should carry his Almanac to school every day with his photograph duly pasted and the Student's Personal Record signed by the parent.
- The School gate is closed 5 minutes before the bell. Students will be fined Rs. 5 on late arrival.
- Student should show respect for School property and take care not to damage it in any way. Damage done even by accident should be reported by the student at once to the school Authorities.
- Fancy stationary & expensive articles should not be brought to school.
- Lending or borrowing of money and other articles is not permitted.
- Jeevan Jyoti Global School Students should be polite and courteous wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their behavior.
- Bullying and using foul language are punishable offences, chewing betel leaves, paan masala , use of drugs, gambling and smoking would lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
- Teachers, parents and guests should be greeted respectfully by students.
- Once a child has come to school, he/she is not allowed to go on half day or take leave for any period, unless there is an emergency. Proper gate pass is a must before going.



- Students found tampering and tinkering with the school records and damaging/disfiguring school property is liable to face strict disciplinary action.
- Students should strictly adhere to uniform specifications.
- The school reserve the right to suspend, to take strict disciplinary against a student whose conduct is consistently undesirable in any way.
- A Child may be granted continuous leave for one week in a very special case only by the principal. Prior application should be sent to the school, duly signed by the guardian/parent of the child.
- During examination, no leave will be granted except on medical grounds.
- No students are allowed to come to school on a self driven bicycle from Pre Nursery to I. Parking fee of Rs. 150/- per cycle per month will be charged from the students of class II onwards.
- Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones, data storage devices, CDs or any undesirable material other than prescribed by the school.
- It is expected from senior students to treat the juniors and little ones with love and affection while juniors should show all respect to their seniors.



Code of conduct for students

The following acts and conducts on the part of the students will amount to misconduct.

1. Misbehavior towards other students or any other employee of the school.
2. Intentional disturbance in the classes.
3. Absence from classes without permission.
4. Bullying/intimidation of others.
5. Eve teasing / misbehavior towards girl- students.
6. Damaging/disfiguring school property.
7. Propagating a strike/disruption of class.
8. Association with banned organizations.
9. Propagating communal/caste feeling amongst the students.
10. Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
11. Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher, principal.
12. Bringing unauthorized people /articles inside the school.
13. Theft/pilferage of school/students property.
14. Any behavior unbecoming of a student.
15. Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.

In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take a suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include.

1. Oral or written warnings to the student and parents.
2. Suspension from attending classes/school for a specified period.
3. Recovery of loss to school property.
4. Issue of transfer certificates.
5. Expulsion/Rustication from the school.
